*We need to Increase Punishment of Illegal Firework Sellers to Include **Asset Forfeiture**, as covered in HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE SECTION 11469-11495 – http://www.leginfo.ca.gov/cgi-bin/displaycode?section=hsc&group=11001-12000&file=11469-11495

Assets seized by law enforcement would be recycled into Firework Task Force funding toward operations.

Funding needed for:

Personnel, Overtime Hours, Firework Disposal, Training, Experience, Transportation

*Safe and Sane Fireworks Not Cited by L.A. SME (Subject Matter Expert), Greg Dahlmeier, to be a Problem.

However, as he and others educate police and other agencies about illegal versus legal fireworks, I do believe a study of states like Massachusetts—which has banned all consumer fireworks—should be made.

Gardena P.D. has organized a meeting around the topic of fireworks leading up to, and around the fourth. Their being a city that allows "safe and sane" fireworks has confused officers at times.

Could this be true with other agencies?

Do Safe and Sane fireworks, the presence of those selling outlets—lead buyers to higher level fireworks?

I still have questions about Safe and Sane—even though the SME does not, and feels they are not a problem.

New Jersey and Delaware are other states with consumer ban on all fireworks.

My questions range, but one is:

Does allowing *some* fireworks in, lend to bigger ones being justified by low-level criminals?

What *POPS*, or loud sounds are legal? I don't know, and I think lots of us (including law enforcement) do not know, as lines are blurry...



*Funding for Education in Public Schools Needed

Law education, Civics, Firework laws, Safety/Fire Safety...
