# **Asset Forfeiture – Illegal Fireworks**



### 1. PROPOSAL SUMMARY

Apply CA Health and Safety Code 11470 to Illegal Fireworks, allowing "Asset Forfeiture" to be used as a law enforcement tool to eliminate wide scale bomb traffic in California.

### 2. PROBLEM.

As Deputy Chief John Todd of L.A. County Fire has noted: <u>Illegal Fireworks is a</u> booming trade because profits are high, and punishments are low.

Asset Forfeiture would slap illegal firework trading/using in the face, put the state's foot down on an explosively bad practice of personal firework use.

One that hurts quality of life for vets and others with PTSD (Post Traumatic Stress Disorder), Animals/Pets and their owners, All Fire Safety officials and experts nationwide who warn of fire dangers of personal and illegal fireworks; Law Enforcement trying to "keep the peace" and eliminate dangerous threats.

Right now, just focusing on L.A. County arson investigators and their great ability to put an effective task force against fireworks together: despite their talent and effectiveness, there is not enough money, resources, personnel and hazardous waste storage space to put the dent law enforcement has put into "controlled substances" through Health and Safety Code 11469-11495.

## 3. SOLUTION.

Applying Asset Forfeiture to Illegal Firework law enforcement would cripple the illegal business, hit illegal sellers in the wallet—making the risks so high to get into the black market trade, that most would get out of it, that are now in it relatively risk-free.

ALSO: Assets forfeited by illegal manufacturers and sellers would be recycled by Illegal Firework Task Forces, like that put together by L.A. County Fire.

They would Grow with every bust, until they would have the resources to fund their antifirework task force 365-days of the year!!

#### 4. COST.

This would only bring Illegal money <u>into</u> the State of California—turn it around into legal ventures—ideally a year-round task force to combat illegal firework manufacture, trading and using.

Legal Costs to propose a bill and change the Health and Safety Code—paperwork bills, mail and clerk costs only.
